

# Forbidden!

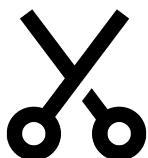
## Level 1



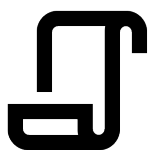
80 game cards with a well-balanced mix of nouns, adjectives, and verbs covering all areas of vocabulary: places, people, activities, feelings, things...



A fun game which makes your students think outside the box, develop their describing skills, and improve their vocabulary.



Print-ready design: just print it out, cut the cards and you're good to go!

Recommended language level: A2-B1/B2

# Rules

Cut out the cards and give them to your students, keeping the cards face down. A student picks a card, doesn't show it to the others, and tries to describe the word in bold without using the four other words on the card – they are *forbidden*. It's also forbidden to use the root words (e.g. weekend: *week*, *end*). Students take turns describing the words. The other students are trying to guess the word.

The student who describes the word gets two points if another student successfully guesses their word, and the one who guessed the word gets one point. And the student with the most points wins!

The game is also a lot of fun without keeping score, and it can even be played in 1-on-1 classes between a teacher and their student.

## Example

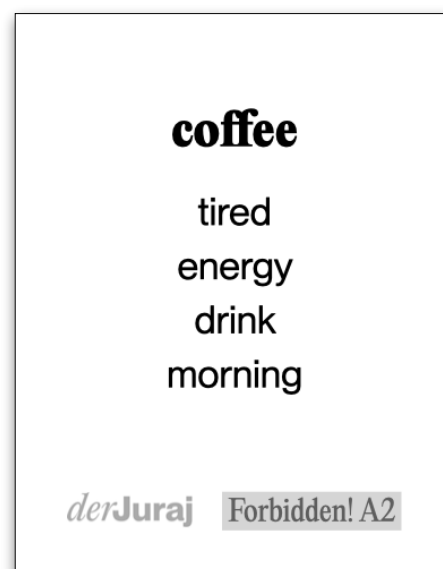
Target word: coffee

Forbidden words: tired, energy, drink, morning

*"This word is a noun, it's basically water with something, lots of adults love it and have it every day, it's usually brown or dark..."*

## Tips

- If your students struggle with some of the cards, allow them to use one of the forbidden words.
- If you want to make the game extra challenging and competitive, give each student a time limit (e.g. 2 minutes) and see who can manage to describe the most words!
