 - The noun *information* is uncountable.
 - Employers can find a lot of **information** about their employees online.
2. That's outrageous! Never in my life have I been treated so rudely. ✓
3. Have you heard Tom and Kate are dating? I think they're a lovely **pair**.
 - When talking about two people in a romantic relationship, use the noun *couple*.
 - Have you heard Tom and Kate are dating? I think they're a lovely **couple**.
4. **Today morning** was pretty rough – I overslept and spilled my coffee.
 - “Dnešní ráno” = *this morning*, also *this afternoon*, *this evening* and *tonight*.
 - **This morning** was pretty rough – I overslept and spilled my coffee.
5. There weren't enough chairs in the room, so we had to sit on the **ground**.
 - *Ground* refers to outdoor natural surfaces, use *floor* to talk about surfaces indoors.
 - There weren't enough chairs in the room, so we had to sit on the **floor**.
6. We discussed **about** the current political situation in the Middle East.
 - “Diskutovat o něčem” is used without a preposition: *discuss something*.
 - We **discussed** **Ø** the current political situation in the Middle East.
